"I got married when I was barely 18years old, and delivered my first child at home," said Ms Bahero. Her subsequent deliveries also took place at home.

"As a marginalized community, we were ignorant about the importance of antenatal care, largely because we didn't have a health center in Kiwayuu."

The community relied heavily on the services of traditional birth attendants who had limited skills and knowledge. "In the event of pregnancy-related complications, or even maternal deaths, we would conclude that it was God's will." She explained. When she went into labor for the 5th child, she thought she knew what to expect.

"I was set to deliver to deliver at home as usual." "The traditional birth attendant who helped me deliver in the past was at hand to assist" But it gradually become clear something was wrong.
